Donor Rights: Transparency and Trust in Philanthropy

At the core of philanthropy is a shared belief that every act of giving, no matter how small, has the power to make a difference. That's why we're committed to transparency and trust in all our fundraising efforts. To ensure donors feel confident in their support of Radiant Health, we declare that all donors have the following rights:

Informed about Radiant Health	The right to be informed of the organization's mission, how the organization intends to use donated resources, and its capacity to use donations effectively for their intended purposes
Board Leadership	The right to be informed of the identity of board members, and to expect the board to exercise prudent judgment in its stewardship responsibilities
Financials	The right to access the organization's most recent financial statements
Good Stewardship	The right to be assured that their gifts will be used for the purposes for which they were given
Gratitude	The right to receive appropriate acknowledgement and recognition
Confidentiality	The right to be assured that information about their donations will be treated confidentially and with respect, to the extent provided by law
Professionalism	The right to expect all relationships with individuals representing Radiant Health will be professional in nature
Affiliation with Radiant Health	The right to know whether those seeking donations are Radiant Health volunteers, employees, or hired solicitors
Privacy	The right to have their names removed from mailing lists that the organization intends to share
Timely Truth	The right to ask questions when making a donation and to receive prompt, truthful, and forthright answers
